8	Labour Force	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trained & qualified labour • Engineers • Designers • Escalation to 100 operatives • Consultants • Experienced and qualified flood defence team

2	Site Management & Control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NEBOSH, SMSTS, CDM, UKPIA, CSCS, IOSH, training and qualified staff at various levels • Appointed Persons, Team Leaders & Supervisors • Safe Site Systems for planned and emergency site management of third parties • Staff trained in asbestos, chemical, biological, electrical, confined space, hazard awareness • Staff experienced in use of all equipment including BA sets, test kits, specialist pumps & barriers
3	On Site Capability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Site and incident management • Inflatable boats for moving equipment • Mobile flood barrier erection and maintenance • Vehicles with wading capability (to 1m at present, limited no. of vehicles) • Emergency rescue capability • Pumping water via Sockit to surface or foul discharge • Rapid workforce escalation capability • Removal of waters by vacuum tanker • Temporary storage tank erection • Disposal of contaminated water • Chemical and biological contamination assessments
4	Post Incident Capability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Toxicological Survey • Soft strip of equipment and fixtures • Removal of affected masonry • Sanitisation of surfaces • Dehumidifiers • Contaminated land assessment and remediation
