

Separator System Audit

Adler and Allan's Separator System Audit is designed for installations where there is insufficient information regarding the current condition and functionality of the separator. We conduct an audit and provide a report detailing the status of the separator and what cleaning or replacement parts are needed, to ensure that the separator system can operate efficiently, prior to entering into a Service Contract. All audits are carried out under the Environment Agency's PPG3. Our engineers will carry out a full audit of your separator and help resolve any issues identified.

They will make sure that it has been modelled on the requirement detailed in the Environmental Agency / Scottish Environment Protection Agency PPG3 and the European Standard EN858-2 and has been installed as per the manufactures instructions and what service is required for it to work to its best capacity.

During the Separator System Audit our qualified and experienced Electrical and Service Engineers undertake the following investigations:

- Establish the type of separator, if not known
- Establish that the alarm system has been installed correctly and working properly
- Establish coalescing filter condition
- Compile a log, detailing servicing and cleaning to date
- Measure light liquid, oil and solid levels and record in the log
- Complete a full and detailed written report and detail what service details are required
- Provide a FREE Service Voucher for your first service, if the service contract is taken.

Once the audit is completed all separators must have regular maintenance and servicing undertaken.

Other Services

Separator Servicing

We offer a low cost regular service that will keep your pollution prevention equipment working at the optimum efficiency level and manage your service log that you are required to keep. All these are required to keep you compliant to PPG3.

Alarm Installations

We fit new alarms that will avoid unnecessary emptying whilst ensuring that overflow is avoided and preventing pollution from occurring. This will not only reduce your waste management costs but could keep you from any potential costly fines. It is important to remember that this equipment also needs to be regularly serviced.

Commissioning
